Brief history of South Gambier Football Club:

Mount Gambier is the commercial centre of the Lower South East of South Australia. Built on the slopes of an ancient volcano, its alternatively known as the 'Blue Lake City'. The Blue Lake is the South East's largest and most popular attraction, but there are a number of other, if not quite as spectacular lakes and craters in the District. The city has many fine examples of colonial architecture built using the distinctive local Mount Gambier Limestone. Mount Gambier's major industries are timber, dairy products, especially cheese, vegetables and wool.
